



BRITISH GAS SWIMMING CHAMPIONSHIPS 2012 (SELECTION TRIALS)

BRITISH SWIMMING LIMITED

1.0 General Conditions

[a] The British Swimming Managing Board (“the Board”) reserves full powers over the British Gas Swimming Championships 2012 (Selection Trials).

[b] The Championships shall be held at a venue and for a period determined by the Board.

[c] The Championships shall be competed for annually under FINA Rules, the British Swimming Judicial Code and any additional conditions (printed in the Meet Information). Where FINA Rules and the Meet Information differ then the Meet Information shall take priority.

[d] Where FINA Rules do not provide (eg Health & Safety Regulations or Child Protection Guidelines) the requirements of the ASA shall apply to events held in England or Wales and the requirements of SASA shall apply to events held in Scotland.

[e] Entries may only be accepted from competitors registered as members of the ASA, SASA or WASA, or competitors from one of the countries affiliated to FINA. Where required to do so, competitors shall present their passport for age verification to the Events Administrator not later than 15:00 hours on the day before the Championships begin.

[f] A competitor must have been a registered member, or equivalent, of the club in whose name he is entered, at least 60 days prior to the first day of the Championships.

2.0 The Events

Individual:

50m, 100m, 200m, 400m, 800m (Women) & 1500m (Men) Freestyle,

100m, 200m Backstroke, Breaststroke & Butterfly

200m, 400m Individual Medley

3.0 Entries

[a] Entries shall be received by the appropriate Championship Administrator (“the Administrator”) by 12.00, Noon on Wednesday 15th February 2012, accompanied by the appropriate entry fee.

[b] Entry times from all ASA, SASA, WASA entrants must be recorded in the Long Course British Swimming Rankings from Swimming Competitions designated or licensed for entry into National competitions since 3rd March 2011.

[c] Entry times from competitors of other countries affiliated to FINA must submit times that are recorded in the Long Course FINA Rankings or Long Course Swim News rankings; or in official meet results from a National Governing Body sanctioned competition in a 50m pool and be achieved since 3rd March 2011.

4.0 Officials

[a] Technical Officials shall be selected from lists approved by British Swimming.

5.0 Doping Control

[a] Competitors taking part in the Championships may be subject to random doping control;

[b] Competitors are required to bring with them either a passport or other form of identity incorporating their photograph.
